Horace Hill Recreation Area spans 53 acres and is home to world class mountain biking and hiking trails, 18-hole disc golf course, and various winter uses.

The property was purchased by the Town of Dover in 2019 in order to preserve the land and also provide a space for expanded recreation opportunities within the town.

In 2023, Dover's Economic Development Department partnered with Sinusosity Flowing Trails, Tahawaus Trails, and Disc Golf Park to implement the new amenities which were completed in 2024.
